The main figures in the design highlight the diversity of the students in our school district and the connection to our local traditional Lkwungen communities. The Salmon, the Sacred Tree, the Métis infinity symbol and Inuksuk represent the Aboriginal students in our school district and the black, red, yellow, and white feathers symbolizes all races of people and their connection to each other.

The salmon represents the strength, determination and courage of our students, families, teachers, administration and community members. The Inuksuk represents the peoples from the North. The red infinity symbol represents the Métis and the joining of two cultures. The Sacred Tree symbolizes all Nations and how we work together using traditional and non-traditional tools defining ways of learning, being and communicating.
