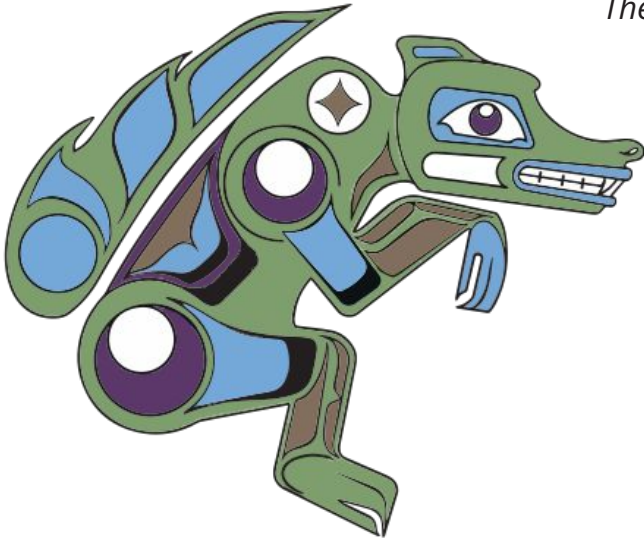


WOLF—Generosity/Social and Emotional Support

The Wolf's gift to the learning process is relational. The **Wolf thrives where communication, respect and reciprocity are valued, modeled, and taught.** When the Wolf's gifts are accessible to students and they are able to weave them into their learning experiences, their abilities to develop interpersonal skills are enhanced. **When students have strong interpersonal skills, they are able to communicate clearly and respectfully when speaking with others and when advocating for themselves.**

A principle of the Wolf's gift to learning involves knowing one's history, generational roles, and responsibilities. Learners with this knowledge understand the interconnectedness of all aspects of life. In order to experience this, learners need to be blanketed by support from home, school, and community.

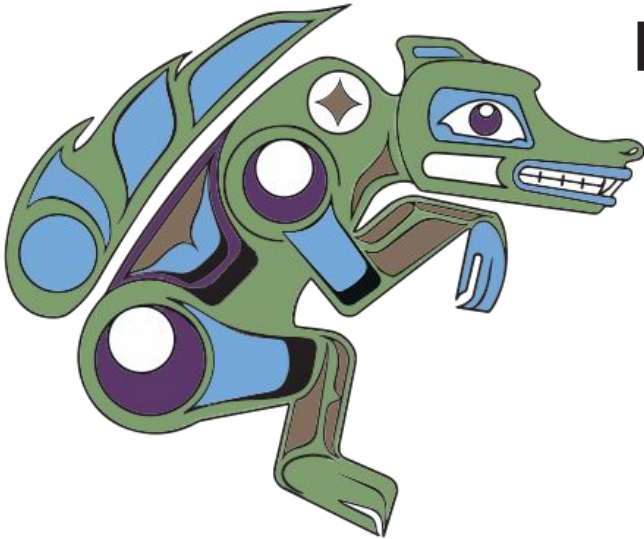

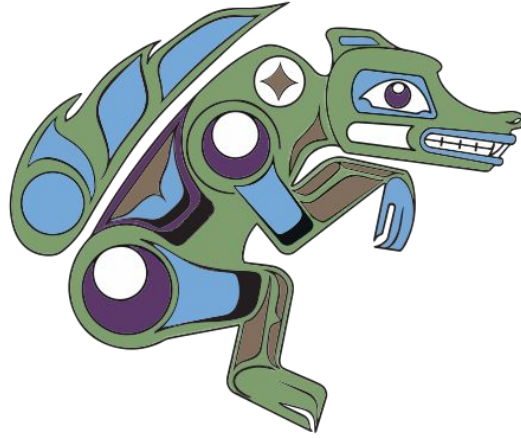

Responsibility

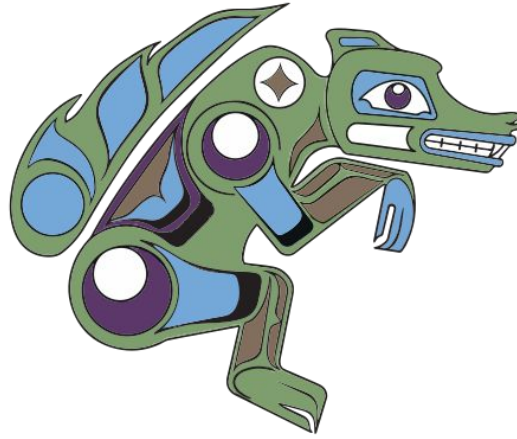
Taking care of our jobs or duties and doing what we say we will do.

Communication

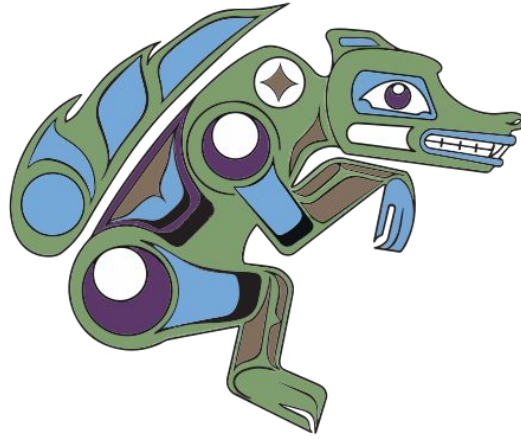
Sharing our thoughts, ideas, and feelings with others by talking, listening, writing, or using actions.

Respect

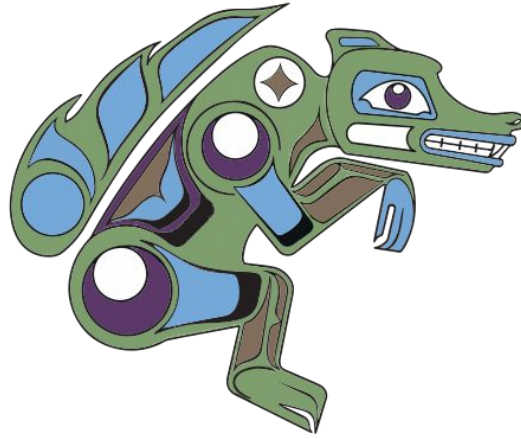
Treating people, places, and things with kindness and care.

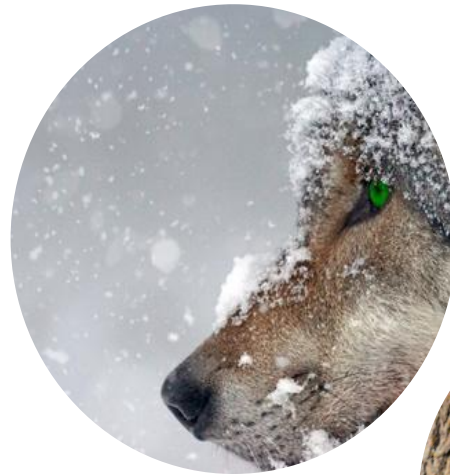

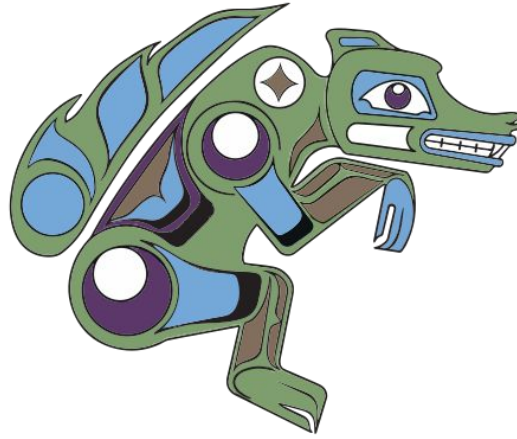


Imagination

Generosity

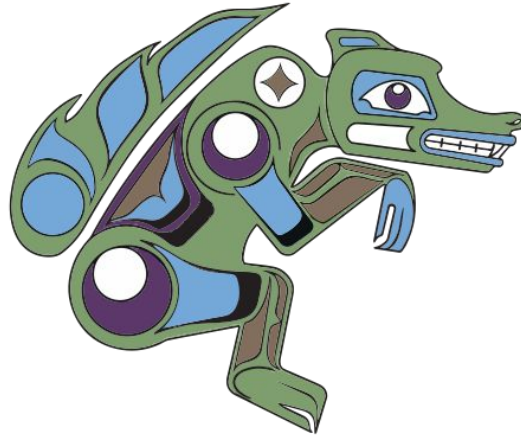
Being kind and giving to others, like sharing our time, help, or things.

Reciprocity

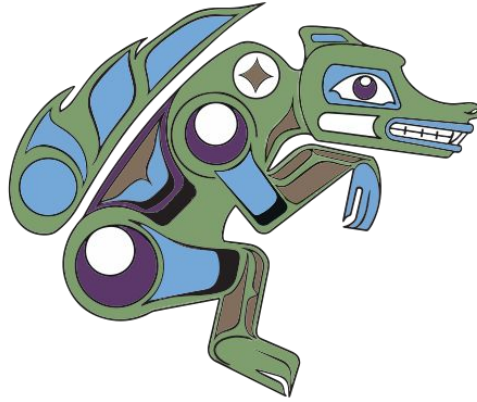
Giving and receiving in a fair way—helping others and letting others help us, too.
