- Proof of enrollment in a full-time program at a post-secondary institution or training center. (Proof is required to receive funds also)
- Good scholastic standing - include a copy of transcript for last two years' marks and the most recent semester completed.
- Community involvement.
- Demonstrated leadership abilities.
- One letter of reference from a school counselor, administrator, or teacher
- One personal letter of reference.
- Provide a brief cover letter describing future plans, accomplishments, and explaining why you feel you are a potential candidate for this award.

Scholarship must be claimed within two years of date of award.

Nella Nelson Legacy Scholarship

SPONSOR: Hulitan Family and Community Services

This scholarship is in recognition Nella Nelson, Klaapalasukwela/Maxwagila. Nella is a Kwakwaka'wakw teacher, leader, mentor, advocate, mother, and grandmother. Born within the 'Namgis Nation of Alert Bay, BC, Nella is a member of the Tsawataineuk Nation at Kingcome Inlet. In 1972, Nella moved to Victoria to study at Camosun College and soon transferred to UVic to pursue studies in Anthropology and then Education (BA '77 and BEd '79). Upon graduation, Nella began a lifelong career as a teacher with the Greater Victoria School District working as a high school history teacher and counselor for ten years at S. J. Willis Junior High, Central Junior High, and Victoria High School then becoming the District Coordinator for the Aboriginal Nations Education Division in 1988. In June 2018, Nella retired after over forty years of ground-breaking and thriving educational leadership within Victoria and throughout the province.

TENURE: Any full-time program at UVic, UBC, SFU, BCIT, VIU, Camosun College or any other recognized post-secondary education or training centre.

1. Student with Indigenous Ancestry from the Greater Victoria School District.

3. Good scholastic standing (minimum C+ average)
4. Plans to pursue full-time post-secondary education.
5. Demonstrated leadership abilities and commitment to community.
