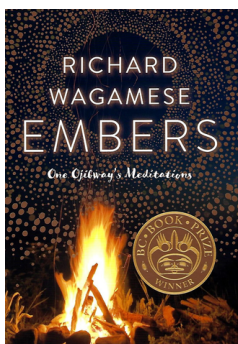
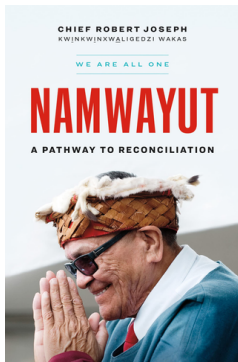
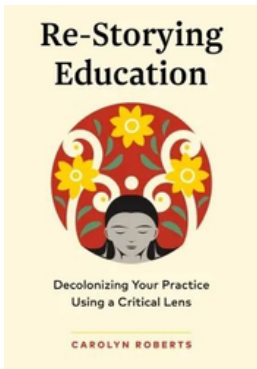
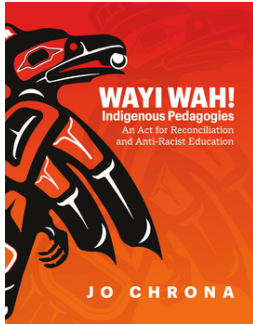
**National Ribbon Skirt Day**

National Ribbon Skirt Day in Canada, observed on January 4, is a day to celebrate the cultural significance of the ribbon skirt and to honour Indigenous culture, history, and resilience. Inspired by Isabella Kulak, who faced discrimination for wearing her ribbon skirt to a school formal, the day serves as a reminder of the importance of respect, pride, and cultural expression of Indigenous people and our regalia. At Esquimalt High School, a student named Jodi Thompson reflects the spirit of this day through her amazing work in her textiles class. By creating and wearing a ribbon skirt, Jodi has embraced both creativity and cultural learning, and she is feeling incredibly proud of herself as she absolutely should be! Her work highlights how ribbon skirts are not just garments, but powerful symbols of identity, strength, and celebration. Next year we recommend celebrating Ribbon Skirts and their special traditional meaning for the week beginning Jan 4 to the 8th.



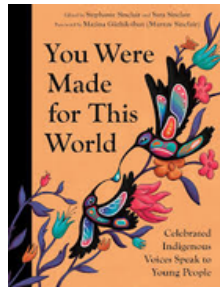
